

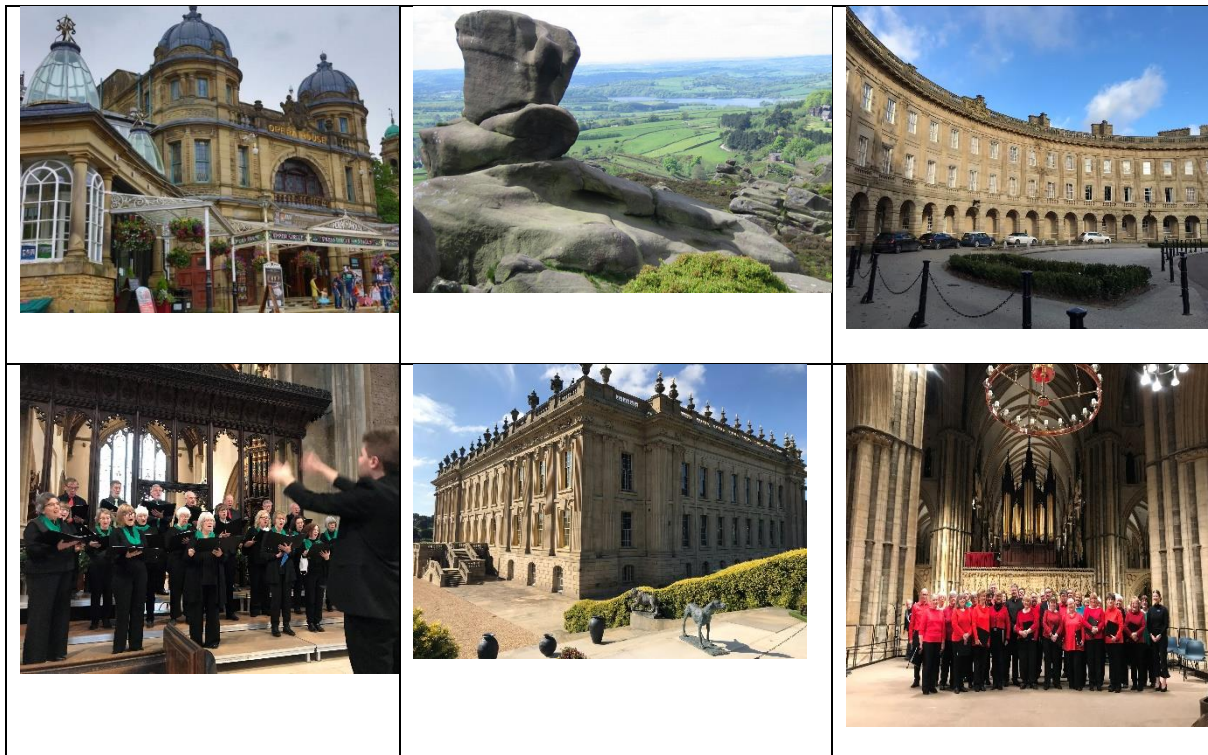


Christmas Delights in Derbyshire

Thursday 1st to Sunday 4th December 2022– 3 Nights, 4 days

It was January 2022 when I started to write up this tour, but looking back I started it in May 2020! It was one of my lockdown projects only to be left on the shelf when our 2020 festive tour was postponed to 2021! So whilst it seems early to be thinking about December 2022, I have actually been thinking about this tour for nearly 2 years! I am therefore delighted to put this out and look forward to visiting an area familiar to many of you, but exploring the delights of Derbyshire together as a singing family with all the bonhomie and festive spirit which pervades our Christmas choral tours.

I'm told that *"Christmas is a wonderful time in the Peak District and Derbyshire; the air is fresher, hot chocolate in a village café tastes better, country pubs seem cosier and the shops and markets are filled with potential presents and festive cheer!"* Who are we to argue with that?!



We have a wonderful itinerary for you with more singing than ever before on a festive tour. We have a visit to the Peak District's most popular tourist attraction – Chatsworth House, adorned for the festive season, two days with a local blue badge tourist guide (of course!), a

visitor experience in Buxton and walking tours of Matlock, Matlock Bath and Bakewell with time enough to get Bakewell Pudding!

In Buxton we are singing in the amazing grade I listed Assembly Room, the Octagon in the Pavillion Gardens in the heart of the town and in a two-million-year-old cavern underground! We are singing in the Cathedral of the Peak in Tideswell, the 'plague church' at Eyam and the grade I listed All Saints Church in Bakewell. We indulge in mince pies and mulled wine and sing at the Barrel Inn at Bretton where we have ordered a clear day so we can see 5 counties! We entertain the visitors on the Peak Railway Santa Special and we take part in the Sunday morning service at St Mary and All Saints Church – The Crooked Spire Church in Chesterfield.

Accommodation and Food

We are staying at the family run Lee Wood Hotel in Buxton, Park Road, Buxton, Derbyshire SK17 6TQ.

Buxton is right in the heart of the Peak District National Park. Three quarters of Buxton is surrounded by the Peaks.

Our accommodation is on a half board basis with bed, breakfast and evening meal included. We are also invited to join in the hotel's Christmas parties after our dinner if we wish to do so!

Travel

You will make your way to and from Buxton

We will have a coach for our visits on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Music

Joe Diggle is to be our musical director for this tour and he will be taking two of the three rehearsals. We will sing from books on the tour.

Our programme will be a festive one drawn from our existing library together with some new songs.

The rehearsals will take place on the following days from 12.30 to 5.30 pm;-

Sunday 18 September 2022 – Venue TBC - 12.30 to 5.30 pm

Saturday 15 October 2022 – Salendine Nook Baptist Church, Moor Hill Road, Salendine Nook, Huddersfield, West Yorkshire, HD3 3SF – 12.30 to 5.30 pm

Saturday 26th November 2022 – - Cheadle Hulme Methodist Church, Ramilies Ave, Cheadle, SK8 7AL -12.30 to 5.30 pm

You will receive your music and CD electronically where possible. Where this is not possible you will receive them at the first rehearsal.

Our rehearsals will be recorded and if there is a suitable signal at the venue they will be live screened and if not they will be recorded and put up on line afterwards.

Itinerary

Day 1 – Thursday 1st December 2022

Today we sing in Buxton - in the Octagon at the Pavillion Gardens and in the Buxton Assembly Room.

You will make your own way to Buxton and to the hotel

11.45 am Meet at the hotel for rehearsal

12.45 pm Depart hotel on foot to Buxton Pavillion Gardens

1.15 pm Arrive at the Octagon at Buxton Pavillion Gardens

1.30 to 2.30 pm Singing on stage at the Octagon at the Christmas Market

We make our way on foot to Buxton Crescent

3 to 4.30 pm Buxton Visitor Experience

4.30 to 5.30 pm Singing in Buxton Assembly Room

We return on foot to the hotel

7.30 pm Dinner at the hotel

Day 2 - Friday 2nd December 2022

Breakfast at the Hotel.

Today we are accompanied by a local blue badge tourist guide as we visit Bakewell, Eyam and Tideswell where we sing in the Churches

9.00 am Depart Hotel and travel to Bakewell

10 to 11 am Recital in All Saints Parish Church, Bakewell

11 to 12 am Walking tour of Bakewell

12 to 1.30 pm free time for lunch in Bakewell to make sure you get your Bakewell pudding!

1.30 pm Depart Bakewell and head to Eyam

1.45 pm Arrive at St Lawrence's Parish Church, Eyam, sometimes referred to as the 'plague church' for our recital at 2 pm

3 pm we head to the Barrel Inn at Bretton for mince pies, mulled wine and singing at the highest pub in Derbyshire, It has panoramic views of the Hope Valley and the Peak District National Park and on a clear day you can see views over five counties.

4 pm to 4.15 pm We depart the Barrel Inn and head to St. John the Baptist Parish Church in Tideswell, known as the Cathedral of the Peaks for a recital. It is known to be one of the largest and the most perfect churches in the area.

4.15 to 4.30 pm Arrive at St John The Baptist Church, Tideswell for a recital – departing around 5.15 to 5.30 pm

5.15 to 5.30 pm We head back to the hotel expecting to arrive around 5.30 to 6.00 pm

7.30 pm Dinner at the hotel

Day 3 – Saturday 3rd December 2022

Breakfast at the Hotel.

Today we head to Matlock with our blue badge guide for a ride and some singing on the Peak Railway Santa Special through Darley Dale! Then on to Matlock Bath. We finish our day singing in Pooles Cavern in Buxton.

9.15 am Depart the hotel by coach bound for Rowsley and the Peak Railway

10 am Serenade the visitors on the platform at Rowsley Station

10.30 am board the Santa Special travelling to Matlock Riverside and sing on board. The train will stop at Darley Dale where we will get off and sing on the platform to the entire train!

11.15 to 11.30 am Arrive in Matlock – short walking tour with our guide followed by free time to explore and have lunch

1 to 1.30 pm Depart Matlock and head to Matlock Bath for a short walking tour with our guide and free time to explore

3.15 pm Depart Matlock Bath

4 pm to 5.30 pm Visit and singing at Pooles Cavern in Buxton a two-million-year-old natural limestone cave. We will make our own way back to the hotel on foot.

7.30 pm Dinner at the hotel

Day 4 – Sunday 4th December 2022

Breakfast at the Hotel

Today we take part in the service at the Church of the Crooked Spire and finish our tour with a visit to Chatsworth House.

9.15 am We check out and depart the hotel by coach to travel to Chesterfield

10.30 am We take part in the morning service at St Mary and All Saints - the Crooked Spire Church in Chesterfield

12 noon Depart Chesterfield and head to Chatsworth House

12.30 pm We visit Chatsworth House - the most popular Peak District visitor attraction. We cannot come to this area and miss this stunning country house which sits in over 1000 acres of beautiful parkland and formal gardens. It will be transformed for Christmas into a festive wonderland.

3.30 pm We depart Chatsworth House and return to the hotel expecting to arrive around 4.00 and 4.15 pm

On arrival back at the hotel we will bid our fond farewells and make our own way home.
