



Salisbury and Winchester Summer 2026

Tuesday 21st to Saturday 25th July 2025 – 4 nights, 5 days

Our summer 2026 tour takes us to Hampshire and Wiltshire, where at last we get to visit Stone Henge (especially for you Sonia!). We are staying in Salisbury and have guided tours of Salisbury and Winchester and visits to Salisbury Cathedral and Winchester Cathedral. We are visiting and singing at The Hospital of St Cross in Winchester, and singing in St Thomas's Church in Salisbury and St Lawrence Church in Winchester. We are also visiting Stourhead and singing in the Church on the edge of the estate. Our afternoon workshops will take place in Sarum College Chapel which is in the Cathedral close in Salisbury.

Accommodation and Food

We have a choice of accommodation for you in Salisbury! Yes, I know I was supposed to make it simpler for me and Teresa this year, but I was conscious of prices for the single rooms, so I have elected for 2 places to give a choice for single occupancy accommodation.

It is a ten-minute walk between the two, we will have rehearsals and workshops in one venue and dine together in the evening at the other!

We have 15 single rooms, on hold at Sarum College, 19, The Close, Salisbury SP1 2EE, where our workshops and rehearsals will take place in their chapel. It is set in the beautiful Cathedral close, overlooking the Cathedral. This accommodation is described as peaceful, quiet, and similar to a "home" or educational retreat. Breakfast is included.

We also have accommodation on hold at the Red Lion Hotel, 4 Milford St, Salisbury SP1 2AN, on a bed, breakfast and evening meal basis, and we will all have our evening meals there.

Travel

You will make your own way to and from Salisbury and to your accommodation and to the workshops

We will have a coach for touring on days 3, 4 and 5. **However it is very important that you confirm in your application if you require the coach on day 5.**

Music

The programme will be a mixture of music drawn from our existing library together with some new songs.

The rehearsals will take place on the following days from 12.30 to 4 pm:-

You will receive your music and CD electronically.

Our rehearsals will be recorded and if there is a suitable signal at the venue they will be live screened and if not they will be recorded and put up on line afterwards.

Please make sure you attend both rehearsals either in person or on zoom or using the link afterwards.

Our musical director for the tour will be Joe Diggle and we will sing from books on the tour.

Itinerary

Day 1 – Tuesday 21st July – Travel to Salisbury and enjoy our first Workshop, followed by the opportunity to enjoy Choral Evensong at Salisbury Cathedral

You will make your own way to Salisbury and check in to your accommodation. It is market day in Salisbury so you may want to get there early and enjoy a stroll around!

2 – 4.30 pm Singing workshop with Joe at Sarum College Chapel, 19, The Close, 19 The Cl, Salisbury SP1 2EE

5.30 -6.30 pm Enjoy Choral Evensong at Salisbury Cathedral

7.30 pm Dinner at the Red Lion Hotel

Day 2 – Wednesday 22nd July – Guided Tour of Salisbury, Visit Salisbury Cathedral, Sing in St Thomas’s Church, Afternoon Workshop

Breakfast at your accommodation

9.30 am Walking tour of Salisbury with our lovely guide Cheryl who entertained us so well in Bath and Bristol

During our tour with Cheryl we will visit Salisbury Cathedral, a medieval masterpiece, with Britain's tallest spire, largest cloisters, and biggest Cathedral Close as well as the best-preserved original 1215 Magna Carta. We are awaiting confirmation of whether we can sing! We are also visiting and singing in St Thomas’s Church in Salisbury, called “the Church of the angels” as it has more than 250 angels decorating the inside of the Church.

1 pm Free time for lunch and time to explore Salisbury – Choose between a visit to The Salisbury Museum, follow the ‘trail of the Trees’ in the Cathedral Close, and while you are in the Cathedral Close visit Arundells the late Sir Ted Heath’s home or Mompesson House, an 18th century town house. There’s also The Rifles Berkshire and Wiltshire Museum (we know who will be going there!), or if you want to shop and eat you can go to Fisherton Mill or enjoy Salisbury’s Indies – over 200 independent shops offering food, drinks and original arts and crafts!

Times may change here if we get the opportunity to do a lunchtime recital

7.00 pm Dinner at the Red Lion Hotel

Day 3 – Thursday 23rd July – Visit to Stone Henge, Afternoon Workshop

Breakfast at your accommodation

09.15 am Depart and travel to Stone Henge, the world's best-known ancient stone circle, and perhaps the world's most famous prehistoric monument.

10 am Visit and sing at Stone Henge

12.30 Depart Stone Henge

1.15 pm Arrive back in Salisbury from our morning visit – free time for lunch

3 - 5 pm Singing workshop with Joe at Sarum College Chapel

7.00 pm Dinner at the Red Lion Hotel

Day 4 – Friday 24th July – A day in Winchester, Guided Walking Tour, A visit to Winchester Cathedral, Sing at St Lawrence Church, Visit, sing and eat cake at The Hospital of St Cross

Breakfast at your accommodation

9.00 am Depart accommodation by coach and travel to Winchester

10.00 am Walking tour of Winchester with our blue badge guide Rosemary. We visit Winchester Cathedral during our tour. Winchester Cathedral is classed as one of the finest medieval cathedrals in Europe and one of Europe's largest and most historically significant, with the longest Gothic nave in Europe.

12.00 noon Visit and sing at St Lawrence Church, 18-19 The Square, Winchester SO23 9EX, referred to as the Mother Church of Winchester. When a new Bishop of Winchester is about to be welcomed in the Cathedral at the start of their public ministry in the Diocese, the first stop is at St Lawrence Church, to be presented to the Mayor, clergy and citizens.

12.30 Free time for lunch and make your way to The Hospital of St Cross, St Cross Back St, Winchester SO23 9SD

2.30 pm This afternoon we visit The Hospital of St Cross for a guided tour, singing in the Brethren's Hall and tea and cake in the One Hundred Men's Hall tearoom! The Hospital of St Cross is one of England's oldest and largest, continuously operating medieval almshouses

5 pm Depart The Hospital of St Cross

6 pm Arrive back in Salisbury

7.30 pm Dinner at the Red Lion Hotel

Day 5 – Saturday 25th July – Visit Stourhead

Breakfast at your accommodation

08.45 Depart Salisbury

10.00 Visit Stourhead - a Palladian house and world-famous landscape garden. We have a guided tour of the gardens and free flow entry into the house

12.30 Free time for lunch and then make your way to St Peter's Church, High Street, Stourton, Warminster BA12 6QE, which is adjacent to the Stourhead Estate (5 mins walk)

2 pm Visit and sing at St Peter's Church, High Street, Stourton, Warminster BA12 6QE

2.45 Depart St Peter's Church and return to Salisbury

4 pm drop off at Salisbury Railway Station and then on to The Red Lion Hotel and then on to Sarum College
