We have a wonderful itinerary planned. The new format of more workshops has slightly gone out of the window on this one as there is so much to do and see! However, we do start our tour with a workshop at Hallé at St Michael's! During the weekend we are singing in Manchester Cathedral and Chester Cathedral, in Chetham's Library and Elizabeth Gaskell's House, in St John's Church in Chester, (which was the original Cathedral in Chester), in Ordsall Hall and Salford Lads Club! Quite a mixture! Plus, guided tours and guess what? A pantomime!

Accommodation and Food

We are staying at the Crowne Plaza Manchester City Centre, 70 Shudehill, Manchester, M4 4AF. Our accommodation is on a half board basis with bed, breakfast and evening meal included

Travel

You will make your way to and from Manchester

A coach will be included for our visit to Chester on Saturday.

While we are in Manchester, we will use public transport as necessary which will be at your own expense

Music

Joe Diggle is to be our musical director for the tour. We will sing from books on the tour, but Joe is keen to have some of the music sung without books!

Our programme will be a festive one drawn from our existing library together with some new songs.

Our rehearsals will be recorded and if there is a suitable signal at the venue they will be live streamed and if not they will be recorded and put up online afterwards.

The Festive Tour Itinerary

Day 1 – Thursday 3rd December 2026

Today we start with a singing workshop with Joe at Hallé at St Michael's and then head to Chetham's Library for a tour and singing

You will make your own way to Manchester and to the hotel. You may wish to arrive early to enjoy the Christmas markets, they operate across ten city centre sites!

12.00 - 2.30 pm Singing Workshop with Joe at Hallé at St Michael's, 36-38 George Leigh St, Ancoats, Manchester M4 5DG. During our time there we have the opportunity to go around the corner to Hallé St Peter's, and visit the home of the Hallé orchestra's rehearsals and recordings, Manchester's orchestra since 1858, founded by Sir Charles Hallé

2.30 pm Depart Hallé St Michael's and walk to Chetham's Library, Long Millgate, Manchester M3 1SB.

3 pm Visit and sing at Chetham's Library. It is the oldest free public reference library in the English-speaking world. It has been in continuous use as a public library for over 350 years and it's collection has been designated as one of national and international importance. Here we have a private tour and at the end have the opportunity to sing.

4.30 pm At the end of our library visit we make our way back to the hotel on foot.

7.30 pm Dinner at the hotel

Day 2 - Friday 4th December

Today we have a walking tour of Manchester, a lunchtime recital in Manchester Cathedral and finish the day with a private tour and singing at Elizabeth Gaskell's House

Breakfast at the Hotel

09.00 am Depart the hotel on foot for our walking tour of Manchester with our blue badge tour guide Jonathan Schofield with a coffee stop at some point during the morning

11.30 We finish our walking tour at Manchester Cathedral to prepare for our recital

12 noon Lunchtime recital in Manchester Cathedral, Victoria St, Manchester M3 1SX

1 to 2 pm Free time for lunch and make our way via public transport to Elizabeth Gaskell's House.

2.30 pm A private tour, singing and tea and cake at Elizabeth Gaskell's house, 84 Plymouth Grove, Manchester M13 9LW. It is an historic house and museum that celebrates the life and literature of Elizabeth Gaskell, one of the UK's most important Victorian writers

4.30/4.45 pm Depart Elizabeth Gaskell's house and return to the hotel by public transport

7.30 pm Dinner at the hotel

Day 3 – Saturday 5th December

Today we head to Chester, to enjoy its Roman history, and medieval and Tudor architecture. We visit and sing in Chester Cathedral and St John the Baptist Church. We have an early afternoon guided tour of the city and head back for an early dinner and an evening at the Opera House to enjoy the Dick Whittington Pantomime! – oh yes we will!!

Breakfast at the Hotel

8.45 am Depart the hotel by coach and travel to Chester

10.00 am We visit Chester Cathedral, St Werburgh St, Chester CH1 2DY for a guided tour and recital. It is an ancient abbey, and described as an archaeological treasure

11.45 am We make our way to St John's Church, Vicar's Ln, Chester CH1 1QX, where we have the opportunity to sing. It is the oldest church and original Cathedral of Chester.

12.30 – 1.30 pm Free time for lunch and to visit the Christmas Markets

1.30 to 3.00 pm Guided Walking tour of Chester

3.15 pm depart Chester

4.30 pm Arrive Back at the Hotel

5.00 pm early dinner

6.10 pm Depart to walk to the Opera House, 3 Quay St, Manchester M3 3HP

7 pm Dick Whittington Pantomime at the Opera House. We are told "Manchester's pantomime will be paved with gold as comedy sensation Jason Manford and panto favourite Ben Nickless return to the Opera House to star in Dick Whittington"!

Day 4 – Sunday 6th December

Today we are joined by our tour guide Jonathan again who will take us out and about to explore again! We will visit and sing in Ordsall Hall and visit and sing in the iconic Salford Lads Club!

Breakfast at the Hotel

9.00 Depart the hotel with Jonathan and take public transport to Salford

During our time with Jonathan we will visit and sing in the historic Ordsall Hall, classed as Salford's 'hidden gem'! We will also visit and sing at Salford Lads Club which is one of the top three most-visited rock and roll music-related historical sites in the UK! We will have free time for coffee stops and lunch and expect to finish our day around 3 pm and back to the hotel for around 4 pm. These timings may change.
