Thursday 6th June to Sunday 9th June 2024 - 3 Night/4 Day Tour

Following the success of our previous Yorkshire tours it's time to bring you Yorkshire 5!

We have another wonderful and varied programme for Yorkshire 5 - with visits to the ancient city of York, a family owned castle, a RHS garden, a gin distillery and a day out in the Yorkshire Dales, plus some wonderful places for our lunches.

Entrance fees (excluding optional visit to York Minster) and specialist tour costs plus lunch on Friday, Saturday and Sunday are included in the package price.

Accommodation and Food

We will once again stay at Solberge Hall Hotel just 4 miles outside Northallerton (address - Newby Wiske, South Otterington, Northallerton DL7 9ES). We will be on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis.

Travel

You will make your own way to and from the hotel. If you are coming by train Northallerton Railway station is on the North East mainline, and the hotel is a five minute taxi ride away and there are usually taxis at the station, or Linda's taxi if I am available! We will then have coach transport for our days out with, of course, your very own Yorkshire Blue Badge Tour guide! I will provide commentary throughout the tour and ensure you see as much of Yorkshire as possible during your stay, whether it be your return visit or your first visit - all are welcome.

- A visit to RHS Garden Harlow Carr - a northern outpost of the Royal Horticultural Society
- A day out amongst the spectacular scenery of the Yorkshire Dales as we explore 'All Creatures Great and Small' filming locations and visit 'James Herriot country'
- All Accompanied by your very own Yorkshire Blue Badge tour guide - born and bred in God's Own County

Itinerary

Day 1 - Thursday

You will make your own way to the hotel this morning and check in

1.30 pm We depart the hotel and head a short distance to Masons of Yorkshire at Leeming Bar for an afternoon of gin tasting!. A welcome gin and tonic followed by a tour and blind tasting of 4 different samples - it has to be gin to begin!

Following our gin tasting we return to the hotel and settle in ready for an early dinner as we have a busy day tomorrow!

7.00 pm dinner in the hotel

Day 2 - Friday

Breakfast in the hotel

9.30 am Depart Hotel for York

10.30 am Arrive in York for a guided walk through York, taking in the heritage and history of this wonderful city

12.30 pm Lunch at the Old Assembly Rooms, which when built was the first neo-classical building built outside Italy!

2 pm A guided Tour of York Minster. This is optional as we are also going to go to Evensong at the Minster later, so for those who haven't been before I am including this as an option. For those not wishing to do this you have free time in York. Please fill in the relevant section on the booking form as tickets will need to be purchased in advance.

3.30 pm Visit Fairfax House for a private guided tour. This is a Georgian townhouse museum and my favourite museum in York! It has been described as "the finest Georgian town house in England"!

Following this there will be time to get a cup of tea before heading to the Minster

5.30 pm Evensong at York Minster

6.30 pm Depart York and head back to the hotel

8.00 pm dinner in the Hotel

Day 3 - Saturday

Breakfast in the hotel

9.15 am Depart Hotel

10.00 am We visit Ripley Castle for a private tour, a 700 year-old castle with a rich history, magnificent grounds, lakes, deer park and walled gardens

12 noon Lunch at Paradise Café at Daleside Nurseries - where we find Frances Atkins the first female British chef to be awarded a Michelin star

2.30 pm Visit RHS Garden Harlow Carr, Harrogate for a private tour - 68 acres with the longest streamside garden in England

4.30 Depart Harlow Carr and return to the hotel expecting to arrive around 5.15 pm

7.30 pm dinner in the hotel

Day 4 - Sunday

Breakfast in the hotel, check out and leave your luggage

9.30 am Depart the hotel

Today we are having an 'All Creatures Great and Small Day Out' visiting James Herriot country and filming locations. We will be heading into the Yorkshire Dales to see some stunning countryside as we weave through the landscape which inspired the stories of the famous vet! Sunday lunch is included, to be taken mid-afternoon

4.30 pm Arrive back at the hotel and say our fond farewells
