



Cambridge Choir Tour

Thursday 9 to Sunday 12th April 2026 – 3 Nights/4 Days

Our Spring tour this year takes us to Cambridge. Once again we have some wonderful singing locations for you. Plus, as agreed, some singing workshops with Joe and we are delighted that our workshops will take place in different college chapels.

The 3 night/4 day tour takes us on a guided tour to see the best that Cambridge has to offer and a visit to the most instantly recognisable and iconic building in Cambridge, King's College Chapel. Following on from last year when we sang on the roof of Hull Minster and at the top of a lighthouse, we are reaching 'high notes' again singing on the tower of Great St. Mary's Church overlooking Kings College. We are also going punting, of course we are, we are in Cambridge! ... and yes, you've guessed we are singing as we go! Our final day sees us exploring the botanic gardens with a guide and singing in the gardens.

Accommodation and Food

We are staying at Arundel House Hotel, 45-61 Chesterton Rd, Cambridge CB4 3AN, overlooking the River Cam, and a 10-minute walk into Cambridge's historic centre. We are on a bed, breakfast and dinner basis.

Travel

You will make your own way to and from the hotel in Cambridge on the first and last day.

Music

The programme will be a mixture of music drawn from our existing library together with some new songs.

Our musical director for the tour will be Joe Diggle and we will sing from books on the tour.

Day 1 – Thursday 9th April – Arrive in Cambridge – Afternoon workshop with Joe in Corpus Christi College Chapel

Make your own way to Cambridge to the hotel and to the Chapel

2 – 6 pm Afternoon workshop in Corpus Christi College Chapel, Trumpington St, CB2 1RH

7.30 pm Dinner at the hotel

Day 2 – Friday 10th April – Guided walking tour of Cambridge visiting Kings College Chapel. Visiting and singing in Great St Mary’s Church and Tower

9.00 am Depart hotel on foot and meet our Blue Badge Tour Guide Vitorria in the city centre.

09.30 am A walking tour of the city. We enjoy the beautiful university architecture, and all that Cambridge has to offer. We visit Kings College Chapel during our tour, sadly no permission to sing there!

12 noon Free time for Lunch

1- 2 pm Lunchtime recital at Great St Mary’s Church, the University Church,

2.15 pm Guided Tour of Great St Mary’s Church, including a visit to the tower overlooking King’s College and 360-degree views of the city, where we also have the opportunity to sing!

7.30 pm Dinner in the Hotel

Day 3 – Saturday 11th April – We enjoy punting down the river and singing as we go!

9.45 am Depart Hotel and walk to our punting station

10 am We embark on our private guided tour on chauffeured punts with the opportunity to sing as we go and entertain passers-by on the river!

11.30 am Free time for lunch and to explore Cambridge. Choose from the Fitzwilliam Museum with over half a million artworks and objects. The University Museum Of Zoology, the Museum of Archaeology and Anthropology, Kettle's Yard Art Gallery or the Museum of Cambridge, or simply explore the market square for food!

3 pm Sing in Little St Mary’s Church

3.30-5.30 pm Singing workshop with Joe at Emmanuel College Chapel, St Andrew's Street, Cambridge, CB2 3AP

7.30 pm Dinner at the hotel

Day 4 – Sunday 12th April – Private tour and Singing at Cambridge University Botanic Garden

09.30 am Depart hotel and walk to the Botanic Garden

10.00 am A guided tour of the Botanic Garden with the opportunity to sing at the end on Cory Lawn. Following our guided tour and singing there will be free time to spend in the gardens and then make your way into the city for a group lunch

1.00 pm Group lunch at the historic Eagle Pub, one of the oldest pubs in Cambridge, 8 Bene’t Street, CB2 3QN. Following this we say our fond farewells!
